Paul Markowitz, Senior Living Specialist, helps folks find a new place to call home

For Paul Markowitz, the most gratifying part of his job is knowing he makes a difference in someone's life. Through his business, Senior Living Specialists, Markowitz continually brings smiles to senior citizens' faces after helping them find the perfect residence.

Betty now lives at The Legacy at Willow Bend; Markowitz refers to her as the "Michael Jordan of the assisted living section."

Markowitz was laid off from his job in April, and said it turned out to be a blessing in disguise. Now, he can devote all of his time to SLS. He felt it was important to create a free service for other families who are in the same situation he was in.

Working with families from the beginning, he guides them through the entire process. He begins by meeting the son or daughter to discuss the needs of their parent. From there, he makes three to four appointments at various senior communities, and goes with the family to each one, where he asks a series of questions to allow the family to make an accurate decision.

Finding the community is just one piece of the puzzle. The other is helping the senior move out of their home. Markowitz offers a comprehensive list of resources, including a packaging service company, movers, real estate

agents, financial advisors, elder care attorneys — basically anything the family may need assistance with.

He said SLS is intended to help alleviate stress and let the senior make an easy transition to their new home. He added that going with them, being there for support and asking additional questions are vital.

"My goal is for the family to be happy and successful, and that's the most critical part," he said. "I know this is a tough and grueling process. The benefit of us-


ing me is that I have been through this and worked with people in the industry. I believe in the personal approach by meeting with the family and doing everything
